



## Supporting Center Of Excellence ( for Autism )

To promote the concept of social responsibility and to consolidate the principle of community service, The Bank has contributed to the cost of establishing and operating the Center of Excellence for five years at a total cost of more than 286 million SAR. This came within the initiative of Saudi banks, which was adopted by the Saudi Arab Monetary Agency in cooperation with the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development. The Center of Excellence designs to attract expertise, transfer global experiences, support autistics, and its families, which consider being a major and a specialized reference for all autism centers in the KSA.
