Interest-Free Loan Portfolio (Qard Hasan)

A long-term empowerment mechanism designed to support productive families through interest-free funding structures that enable stability, self-reliance, and sustainable income pathways.

Riyadh International Book Fair 2025

As part of its community engagement and cultural empowerment efforts, Aljazira Bank participated with a dedicated pavilion at the Riyadh International Book Fair 2025, in collaboration with the Literature, Publishing and Translation Commission. The Bank distributed the Group's publications free of charge to visitors and specialists, taking a first-mover step through this initiative and reinforcing access to knowledge as a meaningful form of community empowerment.

“Mawrouth” (Heritage) Project

Launched in conjunction with the Year of Handicrafts, “Mawrouth” reflects a community empowerment lens that goes beyond financial support, by investing in heritage, identity, and the people behind traditional crafts. It reinforces cultural continuity while enabling skills and participation through structured community programming.

“Mubtakeroon” Game Programming & Development (10th Edition)

Within the innovation and entrepreneurship pathway, “Mubtakeroon” continued to develop youth capabilities through future-oriented skillbuilding. In 2025, the program marked its 10th edition with a focus on game programming and development, aligning innovation support with practical digital skills grounded in technical creativity.

Community Participation

The CSR policy elevated participation into a more structured, replicable practice, deliberately oriented toward measurable and meaningful impact.

Employee Volunteerism and Engagement

Aljazira Bank encourages employees to take part in community and environment-oriented initiatives, reinforcing a workplace culture where giving is part of shared responsibility. In 2025, employee participation included hands-on involvement in environmental programs such as a tree-planting initiative in partnership with the Saudi Botanical Society and an awareness initiative, coinciding with Environment Week under the slogan "Our Environment Is a Treasure" reflecting practical engagement alongside community partners.

Empowering Volunteers Through Capacity-Building

Beyond direct engagement, the Bank supports initiatives that strengthen volunteer readiness within the non-profit sector. In 2025, this included implementing a Training of Trainers (TOT) initiative in the Asir region through the Ataa Voluntary Group, designed to build volunteer capability and enable more sustainable, organized volunteer impact. The Bank also supported programs that prepare youth cadres to contribute effectively within non-profit organizations, reinforcing structured volunteerism.

Employee Giving and Social Solidarity

Participation also extends beyond volunteering time to include employee-driven solidarity. Through internal giving and social contribution, employees helped support community needs, including contributing toward treatment costs for children with disabilities, and ongoing charity (Sadaqah Jariyah) offered by the Bank's employees on behalf of departed colleagues; a gesture that embodies a culture of social responsibility rooted in dignity and inclusion, and committed to creating impact that resonates in real lives.

Knowledge Sharing and Community Platforms

Aljazira Bank further supports community participation by sharing experience and strengthening collaboration through professional platforms. Conferences, exhibitions, and community engagements are used to present working papers and highlight successful experiences in social responsibility. Activities linked to Social Responsibility Day (March 23) also serve as a moment to engage "success partners".

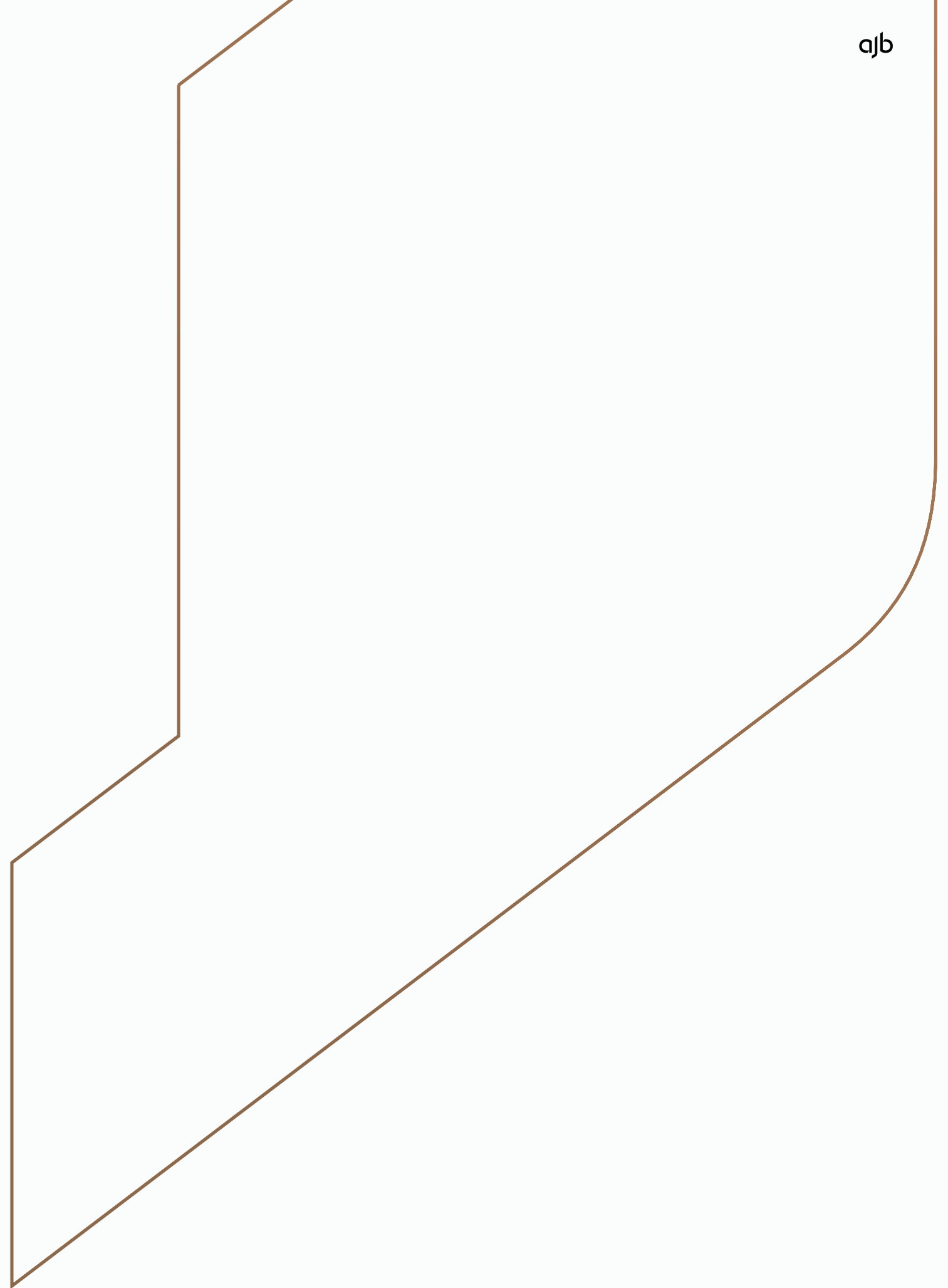
